FACT SHEET FOR DELEGATES AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS

WHERE WHEN AND WHAT:

On the campus of Florida Southern College in Lakeland, Florida. From Sunday, June 18th through Saturday, June 24th, 2023.

S4TL is a weeklong program of lectures, discussions, "rap sessions", motivational talks, and interchanges of ideas/concepts to improve leadership abilities. Life is in a university dormitory, with recreational and entertainment programs included. Leadership in action happens by participation in the actual operation of the S4TL program.

SPONSORED BY:

Districts 6890, 6950 and 6960 of Rotary International. The Rotary Clubs pay the Seminar registration fee of \$750.00 per delegate, provide the delegate transportation to and from the Seminar, and provide Rotarians at "rap sessions" each day of the Seminar.

WHAT IS PROVIDED:

All lecture/presentation materials/books, short-sleeved sport shirts for wear during the Seminar, and towels and sheets. Each delegate is required to bring their own pillow(s) and blanket(s) for their assigned bed.

DORMITORY LIFE:

A delegate lives in a dormitory and shares a room with one other delegate.

WHAT TO BRING (SUGGESTED):

Each delegate is required to bring their own pillow(s) and blanket(s) for their assigned bed.

Jeans/shorts but no bib-overalls please, (the first-year delegate shirts are gold/yellow), personal toiletries, laundry soap, extra towels, sports equipment, swimsuits, and an alarm clock.

There will be an opportunity to display a talent if you have one, so be sure to bring along your instrument, costume or whatever is necessary to display your talent.

MONEY NEEDED:

Very little - other than for snacks and some items at the University Book Store, there will be little to buy. S4TL shall not be liable for the loss of money, jewelry, or any other valuables.

HOW TO GET THERE:

The sponsoring Rotary Club will arrange to pick up each delegate and deliver him/her to the Seminar between 2:00 and 4:00 P.M. on Sunday, June 18th, 2023. If the sponsoring Rotary club has not contacted you by May 19th, 2023, please contact me, Dawn Carson at (813) 495-6307. The same Rotary Club will make arrangements to pick up each delegate at S4TL on the following Saturday, June 24th, 2023 and depart from Florida Southern College at about 1:00 P.M. that afternoon.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Delegates attending S4TL will abide by all reasonable standards of conduct. S4TL has very few formal rules. The basic rules listed below will be strictly adhered to:

- 1. There will be **NO** possession or drinking of alcoholic beverages or possession or use of narcotic drug by any delegate (other than those medically prescribed).*
- 2. There will be no possession or use of fireworks or other explosive items. *
- 3. Delegates are **prohibited from driving vehicles** of any kind to, during, or from the Seminar.*
 4. Delegates must remain in their **assigned dormitory rooms** after lights out.
- 5. Delegates **may not** leave the campus unless accompanied by a Rotarian Staff member.
- 6. Cell phones are **not allowed in or to be used** during seminar sessions.
- * VIOLATION OF ANY OF THESE THREE RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM S4TL AND RETURN HOME AT THE DELEGATE'S EXPENSE!

Dormitory rules (as prescribed by the College) for use of facilities, lights out, safety, and security will be followed. (These will be provided upon arrival at S4TL).

SENIOR/JUNIOR STAFF:

The Senior Staff (planning and supervisory) is comprised of outstanding Rotarians and spouses, and specially invited adult leaders with years of S4TL/leadership experience. The Junior Staff (advisory/aides) is comprised of returning second year delegates.
